- Two reinstatement options

PRIMARY PUBLIC COMPANY D&O

3-Year Peak Market Capitalization of \$800M

- No subrogation against insured person
- · Automatic retiree director discovery period
- Personal profit/fraud exclusion does not apply to Securities Act of 1933 claims
- 90-day post policy reporting period
- Advancement of indemnification if insured organization fails or refuses to advance within 60 days of such indemnification request
- Bankruptcy or insolvency of insured organization shall not relieve the insure under policy
