TARGET CLASSES

- Primary Operations:
 - Crane rental with/without operator, rigging and millwright
 - Equipment dealers and rental operations
- Operations including specialized hauling and warehousing (up to 25% of total sales) if associated with the Primary Operations noted above.
- Additional Target Classes: Operations using cranes, such as steel erection and floor/tilt-up panel erection contractors.
- Tower crane and "for-hire" trucking exposures are available if incidental but are exception basis only.
